

Arifi Guesthouse Admission Regulations

Mandatory Identification Requirement

Guests must present a valid national ID (Tazkira) or passport upon check-in.

All personal information, including full name, gender, date of birth, and passport number, must be accurately provided. Foreign nationals must have a valid visa and legal documentation. Guests without a visa or whose names do not match their documents will not be admitted.

Guesthouse Reservation Rules

Familiarity with guesthouse regulations is essential for a comfortable stay. Guests should review all necessary information before making a reservation. Once the booking is confirmed, they are responsible for complying with the guesthouse's policies. Failure to adhere to these rules will not be the responsibility of the management.

Children's Admission Policy

- Children under 2 years old can stay free of charge.
- Children under 7 years old are charged at half price if they do not use additional hotel services.
- Minors cannot reserve a room alone, even with parental consent.
- Guests must be at least 18 years old and present a valid national ID or passport to book a room.

Regulations for Pregnant Women

Most guesthouses do not accept pregnant women beyond 7 to 8 months of pregnancy. However, if a woman is traveling with a legal guardian or spouse, she must provide valid proof of marriage (such as a Nikah certificate) to complete the booking.

Check-in and Check-out Rules

- Check-in time: 2:00 PM
- Check-out time: 12:00 PM

If a guest wants to check out later than 12:00 PM but before 2:00 PM, they must pay 50% of the room rate for that night. Any checkout beyond 2:00 PM will be considered a full night's stay, and the guest must pay accordingly.

Regulations for Foreign Nationals

- Foreign guests must follow the official legal procedures for booking rooms. They must present a passport with a valid visa stamp showing their entry date into Afghanistan.
- Afghan nationals with foreign citizenship are still subject to Afghan guesthouse policies.
- Unmarried men and women cannot share a room unless they are over 18 years old and provide valid documentation proving their legal relationship.

Visitor and Movement Restrictions

- Guests are not allowed to move furniture or transfer belongings from one room to another without management approval.
- Guests are not allowed to visit other rooms. Meetings should only take place in public areas, such as the lobby or waiting hall.
